CARS ON CAMPUS

First-Year Students

First-year commuting students may register and purchase a parking decal for one automobile and one motorcycle per academic year. First-year residential students are not eligible to purchase a parking decal but may purchase two weekly parking permits per semester. Online ordering of parking decals begins in early August.

Transfer Students

Commuting transfer students may register and purchase a parking decal for one automobile and one motorcycle per academic year. Residential transfer students who have completed two semesters at another institution are eligible to purchase a parking decal. Online ordering of parking decals begins in early August.
